She has an MFA from the University of Montana and has been a fellow with the Arizona Commission on the Arts, a participant at the Squaw Valley Community of Writers, an artist in residence at the Caldera Institute, a participant in the 2018 US Poets in Mexico in Merida, Yucatan and most recently a Visiting Scholar at the University of Washington's Whiteley Center at the Friday Harbor Laboratories. She is a recipient of the 2013 Artist Innovation Award by the Montana Arts Council. She lives in Helena, Montana.

She also co authored a children's graphic novel entitled *Thunderous* (2022). She received a regional Emmy award for her work as a writer/consultant on the PBS documentary *Indian Relay*. She served as the Director of Indian Education for the state of Montana for ten years, was appointed to the National Advisory Council on Indian Education by President Barack Obama and currently works at the non-profit, Education Northwest, providing guidance and support for Indigenous education efforts around the country.
